Dean's List

Louisiana Technical College (LTC) actively acknowledges academic achievement of students within the college. Eligibility for academic honors and the Dean's List is defined by Louisiana Technical College (LTC) and applies to all students.

136.1 SCOPE

The Dean's List is a means of encouraging and recognizing academic excellence. In order to be eligible to receive this recognition, a student must achieve a minimum of a 3.500 grade point average for a semester while enrolled in a minimum of 12 credit hours. Students receiving a grade of Fail ("F") or an Incomplete ("I") for the current semester are ineligible for this recognition.

136.2 DEFINITIONS

136.2.1 Dean's List – an academic honor that lists all students who over the course of the previous semester have maintained a notably high grade point average (ex. 3.5, 3.75, etc.).

136.2.2 Grade Point Average (GPA) – a grade point average is computed by dividing the total number of quality points earned by the number of semester hours attempted. These are normally calculated at the rate of 4 quality points for an A, 3 quality points for a B, 2 quality points for a C, 1 quality point for a D and 0 quality points for an F.

136.2.3 Hours Attempted – the total number of hours taken. This figure includes those hours passed as well as those hours failed.

136.2.4 Quality Points – points assigned to course grades. Quality points are used in computing Grade Point Average (GPA). An A carries 4 quality points, a B carries 3 quality points, a C carries 2 quality points.
