I. Economic Development

Teach/Train Designated Citizens for New Jobs in State . . .

II. Workforce Development

Teach/Train/Retrain Designated Existing Louisiana Workforce for More Advanced or New Jobs . . .

III. Basic Skills and Literacy Development

Teach Citizens:

- A. Reading*
- B. Writing*
- C. Computation*

IV. General Educational Development

Teach Citizens Core Courses/Knowledge Required for Diplomas, Certificates, and Associate Degrees

V. Career Skills Development

Teach/Train Citizens Courses/Knowledge Required for Successful Entry and Retainment in Available and/or Anticipated Louisiana Jobs

VI. University-level, Lower Division Educational Development

Teach/Train Citizens Courses/Knowledge Comparable to University-level Freshman and Sophomore Requirements

VII. Secondary School Vocational-Technical Educational Development

Teach/Train high school students and out-of-school youth, exhibiting the ability to benefit from such an educational experience, vocational-technical skills necessary for success in Louisiana's workforce and/or for success in the pursuit of further postsecondary education.
