Background: At the November 2015 Board meeting, the Board approved LCTCS
Policy # 1.047, Program Health Index (see attached). The intent of the policy is to
provide a mechanism to assess program performance in terms of Our Louisiana 2020:
Building the Workforce of Tomorrow and in terms of alignment with regional and
statewide workforce demands while recognizing the need for fiscal sustainability.

A total of 152 programs across the LCTCS have been reviewed using the framework
outlined in LCTCS Policy # 1.047 (see attached list of programs). Conversations are
ongoing with system staff and colleges regarding program recommendations. Program
recommendations include continue, expand, modify, and terminate. Recommendations
requiring approval such as modifying curriculum and terminating loss-leader programs
will be forthcoming to the Board.

History of Prior Actions: The Board approved the strategic sustainability and growth
plan recommendations at the March 2017 meeting. The Leadership Team agreed to
review 1/3rd of all programs each year under LCTCS Policy # 1.047.

Fiscal Impact: Expansions and modifications are intended to increase net revenue.
Terminations are expected to save funds.

Benefits to the System: Reviewing programs will reduce program time to completion,
increase student retention and transfer, and eliminate loss-leaders will save colleges
money.

### Program Health Index

At the November 2015 Board meeting, the Board approved LCTCS Policy # 1.047, Program Health Index as a recommendation of the Strategic Sustainability and Growth Plan. Policy # 1.047 outlines the submission framework to support the Program Health Index review to determine if a program should either continue, expand, modify, or terminate. The Leadership Team agreed that each college would internally review 1/3rd of its programs each year and submit the reviews to the Board Office by the end of each calendar year. This is the second annual review of the colleges' Program Health Index. Listed in the table below are the 152 programs reviewed:
