Recommendation: Staff recommends that the Board authorize Louisiana Delta
Community College to name the new Learning Resource Center at the Winnsboro
campus in honor of the late Luella V. Snyder.

Background: Pursuant to Board Policy 4.003, "the purpose of naming LCTCS college
facilities in tribute is to bring honor and distinction to the college and to provide
appropriate recognition to an individual, a family, a corporation, or a nonprofit
organization that, by virtue of their monetary contributions to the college and/or their
lifelong dedication and service to the institution, have set an example in the community
and in the state for others to follow." This action is in accordance with this policy and
the college's naming policy.

Luella V. Snyder, a lifelong resident of Franklin Parish, immersed herself in her
community in a variety of ways. She served on the Board of Control of the Franklin
Parish Library for 43 years. During her time as board president, the local library
flourished, and she worked closely with the other board members to establish a new
location in downtown Winnsboro and enhance its services.

Miss Snyder has contributed support to many worthy organizations around the
community over the years. She never sought recognition for the things she did for the
Franklin Parish community. She moved quietly about behind the scenes to ensure that
deserving local groups received the financial help they needed to flourish, and there were
many that benefitted from her generosity.


When presented with the opportunity to support the Act 360 project at Louisiana Delta
Community College in Winnsboro, Miss Snyder never hesitated. She knew that
individuals from her community could benefit greatly from having local access to a
community college. To date, there have been three separate cash donations directly from
Miss Luella Snyder or her foundation. She gave \$25,000 toward the local match, \$75,000
to fund the learning resource center, and her foundation, formed after her passing,
recently gave another \$75,000 for other projects on the campus.

In recognition of her support and generosity, we are seeking to name the learning
resource center the Luella V. Snyder Learning Resource Center.

**Fiscal Impact:** The fiscal impact is limited to the cost of signage, which will be funded by the college.

**Benefits to the System:** The naming of this facility will provide a means to recognize the valuable contributions of Luella V. Snyder to Louisiana Delta Community College.
