**SUBJECT:** Authorizing Naming Rights for Delgado Community College

## FOR BOARD ACTION

Recommendation: Staff recommends that the Board authorize naming rights for Delgado Community College, which is in accordance with Board Policy #4.003, Naming of LCTCS Facilities. Delgado Community College requests the Louisiana Community and Technical College System (LCTCS) Board of Supervisors authorize the naming of the Leon Giorgio Forum, a general meeting room (Room 5000) on the top floor of the Delgado Community College Ochsner Center for Nursing and Allied Health Building (Center). This is being requested in honor of the Delgado Foundation President, Mr. Leon Giorgio, who was principally responsible for the coordination of the \$20 million donation for the Center.

**Background:** The proposed naming would acknowledge Mr. Leon Giorgio's ongoing support of Delgado, especially his pivotal role in securing financial support for the new Center on the City Park Campus. Mr. Giorgio was also most recently instrumental with Ms. Gayle Benson's \$1 million donation for the forthcoming Athletic Field House, as well as the Endymion Garden \$500,000 donation, which are also on the main campus. Mr. Giorgio has demonstrated his personal commitment to increasing student access by donating the funds to establish the College's First-Generation Endowed Undergraduate Scholarship. Over the last ten years, Mr. Giorgio has helped raise \$1.4 million for Delgado students by championing the Foundation's signature annual fundraiser, The Roast of the Town.

Mr. Giorgio is a dedicated and treasured civic leader for the city and state. Mr. Giorgio serves as Board Chair of the Delgado Foundation, a post that holds special meaning for him because of his passion for community and technical college education that began with his involvement with the college 25 years ago. He is the Co-founder and CEO of Select Properties, which has been involved in extensive real estate activities throughout the New Orleans area for over four decades. He has served on the boards of numerous civic, academic and business organizations, including the LCTCS Board of Supervisors, Jefferson Chamber of Commerce, which he co-founded 25 years ago, the Ochsner Foundation, the Metropolitan Crime Commission, First NBC Bank, and Greater New Orleans Inc. He has chaired the Jefferson Business Council and the Southeast Regional Coalition of Business Councils and is one of the longest-standing members of the Regional Planning Commission's board. This recommended honor reflects Mr. Giorgio's unwavering commitment to the LCTCS and to Delgado, and is within the spirit of the new Center, which will serve a critical role in addressing the state's nursing and healthcare worker shortage. The proposed Leon Giorgio Forum overlooks the campus and the city to which Mr. Giorgio has dedicated his lifelong efforts. In accordance with LCTCS Policy #4.003, Naming of LCTCS Facilities, and Delgado's corresponding Naming Policy #AD-4310.2, a portion of a facility or designated area may be named in honor of an individual with whom a substantial contribution

has been made to the College. This recommendation has the support of Chancellor Steib, College stakeholders, and the Delgado Foundation.

**Fiscal Impact:** The fiscal impact is limited to the cost of signage, which will be paid for by the College.
