- Certificate of Technical Studies (CTS) in Legal Assistant (CIP 22.0302) with the Industry Based Credential (IBC) Westlaw Fundamentals for Paralegal Training Certificate issued by Thomson Reuters - 4 STARS

Program Termination

 Career and Technical Certificate (CTC) in Net+ Certification (CIP 11.0901) - 4 STARS

Background: The CTS in Health Science will prepare students to enter the labor force in a variety of entry level healthcare occupations or continue the pursuit of a college education in one of the 21 allied health programs of study or General Studies degree options offered at Delgado Community College. This program will provide students with foundational knowledge and skills that will enable them to be successful in the allied health programs and in their employment in the healthcare field. Salary ranges according to Lightcast, Indeed, Glassdoor and Louisiana Workforce is \$26K-34K annually. The college and faculty representatives have identified several partners who offer these types of positions which include Ochsner Health System, LCMC Health, DePaul Community Centers and Crescent Care. Delgado Community College will provide foundational coursework for students to pursue industry-based credentials (IBCs) in Medical Scribe, Patient Care Technician and Health Insurance, each requiring successful exam completion.

The CTS in Legal Assistant will allow completers entry-level access to employment opportunities in the legal field as well as provide them with the academic foundation to continue their education and earn the existing A.A.S. in Paralegal Studies. All courses

in the proposed CTS program are applicable to the Paralegal Studies degree and have an embedded industry-based credential in Westlaw Fundamentals for Paralegal Training Certificate. Per online employment searches, the college reports a legal assistant can earn \$19.73 per hour or approximately \$41,000 annually.

Delgado requests termination of the CTC in Net+ Certification. The program does not meet program sustainability metrics. The CTC has had low enrollment and low completion. Currently only one student is enrolled in the program. Additionally, the college recognized this program is sometimes confusing to students and employers since the CompTIA Network+ Certification is commonly referred to as Net+.

Fiscal Impact: There will be no fiscal impact unless otherwise noted.

History of Prior Actions: There is a history of revising programs to meet student and workforce needs.

Benefits to the System: These requests will allow DCC to better meet student and workforce needs.

Please see the additional information below regarding recent submissions to the LCTCS on behalf of Delgado Community College:

- 1. Certificate of Technical Studies (CTS) in Health Science (CIP 51.0000)
 - a. Entry level positions associated with the attainment of the CTS include such high demand jobs as Unit Secretary, Patience Access Representative, Patient Navigator, Front Desk Agent, Monitor Technician, and Outpatient Technician. The salary range according to Lightcast, Indeed, Glassdoor and Louisiana Workforce is \$26K -34K annually.
 - Our Allied Health faculty have identified several industry partners who offer these types of positions including Ochsner Health System, LCMC Health, DePaul Community Centers, and Crescent Care.
 - c. By earning the CTS in Health Science, certificate completers are much better positioned to secure positions at the higher end of the salary range than those without the certificate. The CTS also increases the likelihood that completers will experience career advancement opportunities at their place of employment. Additionally, many healthcare employers are increasingly interested in soft skills such as interpersonal relations, communication, judgment, and ethical problem solving, and these skills are embedded in the CTS curriculum.
 - d. Although there is no direct IBC match associated with completion of the CTS in Health Science, the CTS does provide the foundational coursework for students to pursue IBCs in Medical Scribe, Patient Care Technician, and Health Insurance, each requiring successful exam completion.

- 2. Certificate of Technical Studies (CTS) in Legal Assistant (CIP 22.0302)
 - a. According to Indeed, the salary rate for legal assistants in this region is approximately \$41,000 annually.
 - b. Students who successfully complete the CTS in Legal Assistant will have the foundational knowledge to sit for the exam to earn the IBC in Westlaw Fundamentals.

Please be advised that the Delgado Community College Curriculum Committee approved a proposal by the department chair to terminate the Career and Technical Certificate (CTC) in Net+ Certification. The department chair provided the rationale that the term "Net+" is misleading and could cause confusion to students and employers since the CompTIA Network+ Certification is commonly referred to as Net+.

Only one student was enrolled in the program as of spring 2023, and independent study classes are included in the Teach-Out plan. There is no impact to faculty, staff, or facilities as a result of this program termination.
