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

FOR BOARD ACTION

Recommendation: Staff recommends that the Board authorize the President and the Chancellor of Fletcher Technical Community College to execute all documents necessary to demolish a building at the LAMPI site located 331 Dickson Road, Houma. The Office of Facility Planning and Control must approve the demolition of this building.

Background: Prior to Hurricane IDA, a building located at the LAMPI site was used for storage and as a facility to house equipment for the Precision Agriculture Training program. During Hurricane Ida, this building sustained significant damage resulting in cessation of all activities at this facility. The programs located in this building have been relocated to temporary space in a leased facility.

A new facility to house the Precision Agriculture Program is currently undergoing design using Capital Outlay funding. Once completed, the Precision Agriculture Program will be permanently relocated to the Schriever Campus. The college proposes using the Office of Risk Management insurance proceeds resulting from the Hurricane Ida damaged property to enhance the new Precision Agriculture facility. These funds will allow an expansion of the footprint of the building and allow the acquisition of additional equipment for the program.

Fiscal Impact: The costs for demolition has not been determined.

History of Prior Actions: N/A

Benefits to the System: The demolition of the buildings will remove an uninhabitable building from the LAMPI site and provide additional funding to the new Precision Agriculture Facility that is currently being designed.
