| Bossier Parish Community College | \$1,065,058 | These funds were used to purchase IT equipment hardware and software maintenance contracts, software licensing and training, and institutional dues. Educational supplies, computer supplies, computers, monitors and printers for existing and new labs. Additionally, funds were used for upgrades to communications equipment and testing services, and security upgrades. |
| Baton Rouge | \$1,086,055 | Payment of salaries and related benefits for IT support staff and computer lab student |
| Community College | \$1,000,033 | workers; various software licenses and maintenance fees; student computer lab copier rentals and supplies; computer equipment purchases. The College made one time purchases of equipment and sofftware for a new developmental math lab. The College also made one time purchases to perform various upgrades of equipment and technology throughout the College. |

| Delgado Community College | \$1,277,722 | Distance Learning was the largest recipient with the purchase of over 3,900 multi-touch displays, They also funded part-time lab assistants in open labs. IT ordered 300 network drops for the college wide network upgrade. Additional items purchased by the Technical Division, Allied Health, Student Affairs and Business and Technology were ADASlink scan for the Motor Vehicle Technology program, Ophthalmology supplies, Ultrasound scan simulator, 28 desktops/monitors and 25 Laptops. |
| Fletcher Technical- Community College | \$248,414 | Partial payment of LONI charges to provide students wireless network for the campus as well as our subscription fees for LOUIS: The Louisiana library Network are funded with Tech fees. Microscope Equipment/Slides/Storage Cases. Anatomy Models. MLT Mini PCR Kits. Certified Professional Biller Certification Site License for Medical Coding Program. The plagiarism/similarity software subscription with Unicheck, Signal Vine's Text Messaging Platform License, and Dynamic Forms annual license were renewed with tech funds. PaperCut print management for student copies. Monitors for Machine Tool Program. Kwikboost charges for student library use. |
| Louisiana Delta Community College | \$238,109 | Salary/Benefits for IT Director and one Associate Professor, student lab computers, and IT supplies |
| Northshore Technical Community College | \$265,389 | Items purchased include IT supplies, software licensing, computers and software for various departments including Library services; security monitoring, and internet & data lines for the various campuses. |
| Northwest Louisiana Technical Community College | \$171,087 | LCTCS Computer MOU, annual Xerox copier/printer rentals and related services for student lab, contracts for assistance with IT maintenance, Hosted Data Services, Computer Supplies, and Software |
| Nunez Community College | \$362,164 | Salary/benefits for IT Support Staff, Internet service, managed firewall licensing and cloud storage, annual music licenses, software subscriptions, router, switch, and Wi-Fi software and maintenance contracts, Audio Visual Equipment for classrooms, miscellaneous classroom support supplies, etc. |
| River Parishes Community College | \$117,422 | Items purchased include: LOUIS Subscriptions; salary and related benefits for Director of Innovative Teaching and Learning to enhance student learning by providing support to faculty on the use of multi-media and other instructional technologies |
| South Louisiana Community College | \$545,187 | Funds were used to purchase new computer and monitors for student computer labs and video cables for classroom technology. |
| SOWELA Technical- Community College | \$417,777 | Funds were utilized to purchase upgraded instructional equipment for various classrooms and labs within Business and Applied Tech, Arts and Humanities, Nursing, Instructional Tech, and Transportation Tech. Main campus and site locations testing centers were updated with testing computers. Aviation and Automotive mobile laptop carts were upgraded with more capable laptops for the program. Graphics Arts Media Production equipment was updated to better prepare students for real world capabilities. |
