Recommendation: Staff recommends that the Board approve a professional services
contract between Bossier Parish Community College and Louisiana State University
Health Sciences Center, effective July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019. This contract is
subject to the approval of the Office of Contractual Review.

Background: Bossier Parish Community College (BPCC) seeks to enter into a
professional services contract with Louisiana State University Health Sciences Center
(LSUHSC) to provide medical direction necessary to maintain accreditation of the EMT
and Paramedic Programs at BPCC. LSUHSC will monitor and approve program
curriculum and outcomes, verify graduate competency, and provide instruction and
medical updates to program faculty and students.

Fiscal Impact: The contract is for a maximum fee of \$148,500.

History of Prior Actions: The Board has approved similar contracts annually for many
years, most recently at the June 2016 meeting.

Benefits to the System: The contract will provide BPCC with the required expertise to
ensure its EMT and Paramedic Programs meet accreditation requirements.
