- Technical Diploma (TD) in Airframe Structure Mechanic to Aviation Maintenance Technology (CIP 47.0608) - 5 STARS

Background: South Louisiana Community College (SLCC) is requesting to remove a prescribed Digital Media Design (DGMD) course and replace it with an elective from the major to allow flexibility for students in selecting courses that will support their area of focus in Digital Media. This change will provide greater employability per recommendations of the Digital Media advising board.

SLCC is requesting to increase credit hours in the Medical Laboratory Science program from 62 to 69 to provide more practicum experience, to add an Anatomy and Physiology course, and to remove the Orientation Course from curriculum at the recommendation of the National Accrediting Agency for Clinical Laboratory Science (NAACLS).



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SLCC is requesting to make changes to the Inventory of Degree and Certificate Programs. Three Technical Diploma names are being changed to align better with their AAS counterparts.

Fiscal Impact: The changes require no additional costs to the programs.

History of Prior Actions: There is a history of revising programs to meet student and workforce needs.

Benefits to the System: The requested change to the Digital Media program will allow for students to specialize in a particular sub-field within the degree and increase their demand within the employment sector.

Adding increased practicum time and the Anatomy and Physiology course to the Medical Laboratory program will better prepare students to work in the industry.
