Background: SOWELA Technical Community College is requesting to replace several Technical Competency Areas (TCA) with Career and Technical Certificates (CTC) per Board of Regents Policy 2.15. There are no changes to the credit or clock hours, unless otherwise noted.

SOWELA is requesting to repackage the existing AAS in Graphic Art to better align with industry and secondary needs. The name of the AAS would change to Digital Communication to better align with industry and Louisiana Department of Education Jump Start pathways. The existing credit and clock hours remain unchanged with the proposed changes.



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SOWELA proposes to terminate the existing CTS - Graphic Designer (32 credit hours), TD - Graphic Art (45 credit hours), and AAS Graphic Art (60 credit hours). They propose to adjust the existing CTS - Graphic Assistant from 23 credit hours to 17 credit hours. They propose to add a TD - Digital Communication (45 credit hours) and AAS Digital Communication (60 credit hours).

The repackaged degree would have the following exit points: CTS - Graphic Assistant (17 credit hours), TD -Digital Communication (45 credit hours), and AAS Digital Communication (60 credit hours). Students would choose from 1 of 2 possible concentrations: Graphic Design or Media Production (both 20 credit hours). A core curriculum will be taken by all students (25 credit hours). The Media Production Concentration includes 5 new courses (14 credit hours) and two existing courses.

Program faculty worked closely with their industry connections to develop the approved curriculum. The local television FOX and NBC stations, as well as the local Cumulus radio station, were brought in to help develop the Media Production Concentration with program faculty. High school partners are pleased with the proposed changes because of alignment with the Digital Media Jump Start Pathway.

Fiscal Impact: The administrative structure and allocation of departmental funds will be unchanged, unless otherwise noted.

History of Prior Actions: There is a history of modifying curriculum to meet student and industry needs.

Benefits to the System: The changes will ensure curriculum is aligned to industry needs and better able to prepare students for successful entry into the workforce.

We propose a repackaging of our existing AAS in Graphic Art to better align with industry and secondary needs. The name of the AAS would change to Digital Communication to better align with industry and Jump Start pathways. The existing credit and clock hours remain unchanged with the proposed changes.

We would terminate our existing CTS - Graphic Designer (32 credit hours), TD - Graphic Art (45 credit hours), and AAS Graphic Art (60 credit hours). We would adjust the existing CTS - Graphic Assistant from 23 credit hours to 17 credit hours. We would add a TD - Digital Communication (45 credit hours) and AAS Digital Communication (60 credit hours).

The repackaged degree would have the following exit points: CTS - Graphic Assistant (17 credit hours), TD - Digital Communication (45 credit hours), and AAS Digital Communication (60 credit hours). Students would choose from 1 of 2 possible concentrations: Graphic Design or Media Production (both 20 credit hours). The Graphic Design Concentration is the existing AAS in Graphic Art. A core curriculum will be taken by all students (25 credit hours). The Media Production Concentration includes 5 new courses (14 credit hours) and two existing courses.
