Background: In August of 2019, Board staff received a request from a college to review and revise existing policy 2.012 to add more clarity and formalization. Board staff made revisions to the policy, created a standard request form for referenda requests, and presented these proposed changes to both the CSAO group and the President's Advisory Council of Chancellors.

History of Prior Actions: Policy #2.012 was originally adopted on 10/13/2010. The Policy was has not been revised since its original adoption.

Benefits to the System: The revisions to Policy #2.012 will add structure, clarity, and standardization for student referenda requests.

The Louisiana Community and Technical College System Board of Supervisors may authorize colleges to collect fees for various purposes. Once non student organization Once such fees are approved and collected, those funds become property of the State of Louisiana, subject to all the rules that govern funds in the State, and the responsibility of the Board to oversee. Given that these funds are often obligated for specific purposes, the Board should be made aware in advance of steps that may jeopardize the funding source. Therefore, prior to a referendum vote of the student body or a vote of the Student Government Association body that may have financial implications, the college must obtain approval from the Board to hold the formal vote. To gain approval of the Board, the following process shall be followed:

- (1) The student organization wishing to seek the referendum must complete the Request for Student Referenda form (attached)
- (2) The Request for Student Referenda must be reviewed and approvedacknowledged by the Vice Chancellor of Student Affairs/Chief Students Affairs Officer of the college
- (3) The Request for Student Referenda must then be reviewed and approvedacknowledged by the Chancellor
- (4) The Chancellor must submit the form to the System Office with a request to be placed on the next LCTCS Board agenda
- (5) If placed on the LCTCS Board agenda, the college should ensure that representatives of the student organization seeking the referenda are present to address the Board

The request for approval should include at a minimum the following elements:

- 1) Explanation of the reason for the referendum;
- 2) Exact language of the referendum as it will appear on a ballot;
- 3) Explanation of efforts to educate students on the referendum issue;
- 4) Anticipated voter turnout;
- 5) Fiscal impact of the referendum;
- 6) Explanation of the appeal process for appealing the referendum result;
- 6)7) Certification by the Vice Chancellor of Student Affairs/Chief Student Affairs Officer indicating support of the item; and
- 7)8) Certification by the Chancellor/Technical College Director indicating support of the item.

- (4) The Chancellor must submit the form to the System Office with a request to be placed on the next LCTCS Board agenda
- (5) If placed on the LCTCS Board agenda, the college should ensure that representatives of the student organization seeking the referenda are present to address the Board

The request for approval should include at a minimum the following elements:

- 1) Explanation of the reason for the referendum;
- 2) Exact language of the referendum as it will appear on a ballot;
- 3) Explanation of efforts to educate students on the referendum issue;
- 4) Anticipated voter turnout;
- 5) Fiscal impact of the referendum;
- 6) Explanation of the appeal process for appealing the referendum result;
- 7) Certification by the Vice Chancellor of Student Affairs/Chief Student Affairs Officer indicating support of the item; and
- 8) Certification by the Chancellor/Technical College Director indicating support of the item.
