Background: Northwest Louisiana Technical Community College is modifying the Patient Care Technician program. The CTS will change from 29 credit hours to 26 credit hours. The CTC in Nursing Assistant name is changing to a CTC in Health Aid. The revised Health Aid CTC will change from 16 credit hours to 8 credit hours. A Career and Technical Certificate (CTC) in Phlebotomy Skills and in EKG Skills are being added as exit points to the curriculum.
