Program Revisions

- 1. Certificate of Technical Studies (CTS) in Patient Care Technician (CIP 51.2601) -2 STARS
 - a. Career and Technical Certificate (CTC) in Nurse Assistant (CIP 51.1614) -3 STARS
 - b. Career and Technical Certificate (CTC) in EKG Skills (CIP 51.0902) 3 **STARS**
 - c. Career and Technical Certificate (CTC) in Phlebotomy Skills (CIP 51.1009) -3 STARS

Background: CLTCC is requesting to replace the Technical Competency Area (TCA) exit points of the CTS in Patient Care Technician with CTCs per LCTCS Policy 1.024 and Louisiana Board of Regents' Academic Affairs Policy 2.15. This program revision includes embedded Industry Based Credentials (IBCs) in Certified Nurse Assistant (CAN), Certified EKG Technician (CET), and Phlebotomy Technician (CPT).

Fiscal Impact: No additional cost will be incurred as a result of replacing the TCAs with CTCs.

History of Prior Actions: There is a history of revising programs to meet student and workforce needs.

Benefits to the System: The revisions will allow CLTCC to better meet student and workforce needs.
